- Serves as an active participant on the RA team and assists RD with area projects and initiatives.
- Is aware of personal issues or areas of misconduct involving hall/area members and informs RD of any major concerns or issues, stepping in to help when necessary.
- Is eager to assist RD with additional tasks assigned by Residence Life staff and does so with a positive and cheerful attitude.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Has been enrolled at TFC for at least two semesters.
- 2. Has no major disciplinary infractions on his/her behavior record.
- 3. Supports TFC Student Handbook guidelines through action, attitude and speech.
- 4. Must have a cumulative GPA of a 2.5 or higher.

### COMPENSATION

The RA grant will be given each semester as determined by the Department of Housing and Residence Life. These scholarships are applied to your student account and may range from \$2,800 - \$3,000/year. The RA is expected to pay normal room and board costs.
